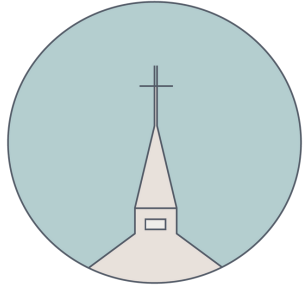

OKOBOJI BIBLE CONFERENCE HELP

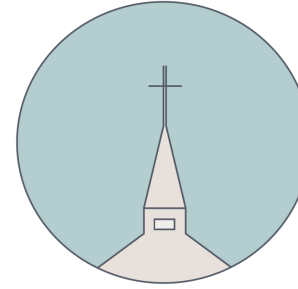
