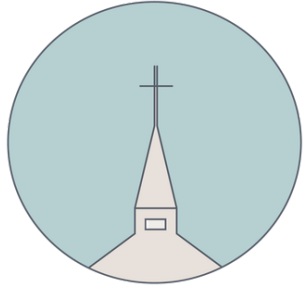

#### FPC BOOK CLUB

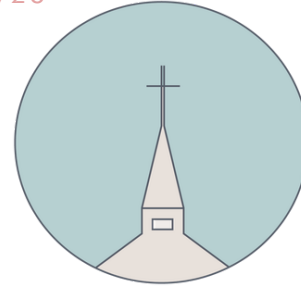
The FPC Book Club meets today at 4pm in the Fireside Room. All are welcome to attend!
